#### **Playgrounds**

Work should be underway by the end of June to repair the play equipment in Valley Road Recreation Ground. Council thank you for your patience and see this as only a start to improving the play areas thoroughly. All areas are inspected regularly.

Council plan to reinstall the football posts on Valley Road as soon as possible.

Unfortunately, unauthorised digging is again taking place at the far end of the skatepark to create BMX ramps and Council wish to make clear that this must stop immediately. There are still plans to build a Pump Park but progress has been delayed as the construction firms are busy during the Summer actually building Pump Parks elsewhere – the planning of such facilities is done during the Winter months.

#### **Bank Vale**

The Parish Council are working closely with St Matthew's Parish Church to promote the sale of Bank Vale Football field - both parties are keen for this to go ahead.. Progress has been very slow due to satisfying the demands of Ecclesiastical, Canonical and Diocesan laws in regard to the proposed sale.

### **The Queen's Diamond Jubilee Celebrations**

The Diamond Jubilee celebrations were a great success and the Parish Council were glad to be involved, working alongside many other organisations within the village. Look out for the Jubilee Committee's newsletter giving more details of the event. The Parish Council are also hoping to plant roses in commemoration of the jubilee by replanting the Sett Valley Bus Station roundabout later this year.

### **Church Street Environmental Improvements**

Derbyshire County Council should soon begin work to alter the Fishers Bridge junction (by building out the kerbline to discourage parking which currently causes visibility problems) and declutter the signing and lining through Church Street and Market Street to improve traffic flow.

### **New Recycling and Waste Collection Service**

Many of you have been asking whether your new brown bins can be removed since you have nowhere to keep them or you have no need for them. There are alternative smaller containers available. Please contact High Peak Borough Council about this on 0845 129 4870 or 01298 28423.
