The proposed double garage placement between the bungalow and the road is out of line with the existing building.

It was resolved that once the Parish Council have all necessary information re arrangements for the event and updates from the High Peak Borough Council, Derbyshire County Council and Derbyshire Constabulary of any planned interventions e.g. temporary road closures then a public meeting would be arranged to inform parishioners about the weekend. Cllr Toft would

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present the meeting supported by other Councillors and groups involved in the anniversary event.

It was resolved that prior to the February Parish Council that Cllr Toft would give a presentation on the Kinder Trespass to Councillors and later to the village in late February or early March 2022
